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INTRODUCTION

This resource book for teachers of Core French classes, grades K - 3, is intended to accompany the K - 3 Core French Curriculum Guide published in September 1987. In the Curriculum Guide, themes, structures and vocabulary items are suggested. The activities presented in the corresponding themes of this resource book will ensure the meaningful practice and use of the structures and vocabulary taught.

While it is expected that students will touch on all of the themes between grades K - 3, the sequence in which the themes are presented should be determined by teachers at the local level. Several themes (greetings, weather, numbers, etc.) are ongoing and will need to be worked on constantly while others (clothing, animals, food, etc.) may be treated as mobile units. They may be repeated at each level but additional vocabulary items should be stressed and different activities used.

In addition to the materials listed separately under each theme, teachers may find the following books particularly helpful. Refer also to the section entitled Additional resources and reference materials.



- 1 Activity: Use following visual to introduce "ça va bien", "ça va mal".




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

Suggested activities for days, dates, birthdays

Suitable
for year

1, 2, 3 Activity: Make large calendar for classroom which students can decorate.

Various uses:

- day, date, month, season, daily
- birthday, special events
- counting days 'til..., etc.

1, 2 Activity: Prepare a chart showing the months of the year. Have the students write their names or draw themselves in the column for the month of their birth.

1, 2, 3 Game: Have all students stand up. Call out a day of the week. The first student able to name the following day sits down, continue with a few more days. The same game can be played using the months of the year.

1, 2, 3 Game: Draw a calendar page on the board, indicating the days by letter. Divide the class into 2 teams and have students compete one at a time. Call out a number and have student give the day that corresponds to the number.

Variation: Call out a day and have student give all numbers that occur on that day.

1, 2, 3 Activity: Have students pick their favorite day/month/season and illustrate it.

- 2, 3 Activity: Have students fold an $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $14\frac{1}{4}$ " paper into eight sections. Have them print one day of the week in each section and cut the sections into cards, mix up, then replace in order, repeating the names of the days.

3 Activity: Recipe for Maple Sugar Cookies

125 mL shortening	5 mL nutmeg
1 egg	375 mL oatmeal
250 mL maple syrup	125 mL milk
375 mL flour	125 mL chopped nuts
5 mL salt	5 mL baking powder

Cream shortening. Beat together egg and maple syrup, add to creamed shortening. Sift flour, salt, baking powder and nutmeg. Add to mixture. Add oatmeal, milk and nuts. Mix well. Grease a cookie sheet and drop mixture onto it with spoon. Bake at 160°C (325°F) for 15 minutes.

K, 1 Activity: Have students squat down with their hands up above their heads. They pretend to be rockets as you count backward from 10. At 0 they jump into the air (causing much commotion not alway appreciated by other teachers!)

1, 2, 3 Game: Write numbers at random on the board. Divide class into 2 teams. Call out a number, students will race to be first to circle it.

K, 1 Game: Stick a tag with a number 1 - 10 on each student. Have them walk around to lively music. Call out any number - the students wearing that number must sit down.


1, 2 Game: Prepare set of cards as follows:



Cut them in halves and distribute at random around the class. Students move around the class trying to find their partner by asking "Est-ce que tu as le...?" When they have found their partner students should come and tell you their number.

- 2 Activity: Ask students to write out their phone number on a piece of paper. Place all numbers in a box. Ask student to pick a paper and read out the number. The student who recognizes his/her number will say: "C'est mon numéro de téléphone" and pick out the next number.


1, 2, 3 Activity: Dismiss students or have them perform certain actions by the colours they are wearing: "Si tu portes le bleu, tu peux partir/marche sur la pointe des pieds/lève-toi/ferme les yeux/etc.

K, 1 Game: Stick a coloured tag on each student. Have them walk around to lively music. Call out any colour - the students wearing that colour must sit down.

1, 2, 3 Game: Distribute coloured cards at random to all students. Divide class into teams. Call out a colour - first student with that colour to touch the board wins a point for team.


1, 2 Game: Draw sections on back of paper plate and colour each section differently. Make a pointer that can spin. Ask students to guess where spinner will stop, then spin and see if they are correct.



2, 3 Game: Use small white envelopes with bars drawn on the front to simulate hutches of different colours (les clapiers). Hide a picture of a rabbit in one envelope. Students guess which cage he is in. "Où est le petit lapin?" - "Dans le clapier bleu" - "Je ne sais pas, viens voir." When students find the rabbit they take turns choosing the hiding place.

Activity: If students are seated at tables in the kindergarten classroom, this activity is useful in September. Draw a table on each of several coloured cards (colours match those of the actual classroom tables.) Distribute one card to each student and ask him to find a matching "table" (en français) and repeat, upon finding it: "la table bleue". The students will recognize this new vocabulary for future instruction.


